

Alumni Survey Responses 2023

EENR Alumni Feedback Survey – Fall 2023

The survey was sent via Qualtrics, an online survey tool, to 144 program alumni. The invitation to take the survey was initially sent in November 2023, with follow up invitations sent until January 2024. A total of 59 alumni responded to the survey, 56 of whom completed their undergraduate degree in EENR, or the former Natural Resource Management major. The other 3 alumni completed their graduate degree in EENR.

Some respondents did not answer every question, or received an earlier version of the survey with fewer questions:

- Thirty alumni reported being employed in a permanent position while 9 were in a temporary position.
- 12 of the respondents were in graduate school.
- 20 respondents were employed in a position in or related to Forestry, Urban Forestry, Natural Resources, or Ecosystem Management. 19 were employed in another field.

Respondent graduation years ranged from 1976 to 2016. The mean graduation year of the respondents was 2014 while the median was 2016.
